- Laxmi Niwas the South wings was built in 1902
- 2. Sadul Niwas the West wings was built in 1912.
- 3. Shiv vilas the East wings was built in 1926.
- 4. Karni Niwas the North wing built in 1924.

The Lallgarh palace: Which is known as the House of the Maharajas of Bikaner-

- 1. Lallgarh Palace was built during 1896-1902 and inaugurated in 1902.
- It was built under the 21st king of Bikaner, maharajadhiraj Ganga Singh Ji Bhadur.
- 3. Main architect of Lallgarh was Sir Samuel Swinton jacob.
- 4. The Palace was converted into Hotel in 1974.

- Tourist attractions: as tourists are living in modern world therefore they are inclined towards the cultural heritage of these palaces. Some special attractions are :

LAXMI NIWAS

Laxmi Niwas was actively used for entertaining Indian and Foreign dignitories by Maharaja Ganga Singh and his fellow princes. It was also used to host social function and parties.

HOTEL BHANWAR NIWAS

Hotel Bhanwar Niwas is located at Rampuria Street. One can visit the Junagarh Fort (Approx. 2km) and Karni Mata Temple (Approx. 2km) from the hotel. Distance from Jodhpur Airport: 314 km (approx.) Distance from Bikaner Junction Railway Station: 2 km (approx.)

The fort is made during the Mughal Empire and has a beautiful architectural design. The other nearby interesting places that one can visit from the hotel includes Gajner Wildlife Sanctuary, Sadul Singh Museum and Jain Temple. Bhanwar Niwas is a living testimony to the splendid architecture of Rajasthan. This heritage hotel is a perfect blend of Indian and European style. A proof of the workmanship of the artisans of Bikaner, the palace was completed in 1927. It was built for Bhanwarlalji Rampuria, heir to a textile and real estate fortune of the region. One of the most stunning havelis of Bikaner, it belongs to the Rampuria family. The décor has 1920s feel and elegance, which has now been clubbed with contemporary comforts.
